

Jeevan Dhara Annual report 2016-2017

On 27th August 2016 we conducted De-Addiction awareness program at Nasha Bandi Maha Mandal. Our staff Mrs. Sana gave a speech on addiction.

On 5th September 2016 Jeevan Dhara students took the initiative to make their teachers happy on the occasion of teacher's day. The students had organized a small party by contributing money and the cutting cake for their teachers at the Cheeta Camp study classes. It was an enjoyable party for the both the teachers and students.



On 14th November 2016 we celebrated Children's day in our study classes at Cheeta camp. The children wore colorful dresses and enjoyed themselves by cutting cakes, dancing and singing songs. It was a fun filled evening for both the students and teachers.



On 10th December 2016 Jeevan Dhara was invited for the women day rally organized by MAVA ngo. The theme was: 1) to spread a mass awareness on the increasing violence against women 2) to reach out to the masses 3) An appeal them to speak up against violence and other gender discrimination against girls and women. The MAVA volunteers did a street play on “Sexual harassment at the workplace”. The volunteers of our Jeevan Dhara were holding the banner and pla cards with slogans on the theme of women’s right and to stop violence against women.



On 11th December we organized a drawing competition for the students from Jr.kg to 8th Standard at Lallubhai compound. The topics were 1) Flower pot 2) Rainy Season and 3) Village. The children drew beautifully drawings and colored them. More than 60 children participated in this competition and the prizes were distributed on the annual day.



On 18th December the children of Jeevan Dhara were invited for Christmas party at the Catholic gymkhana premises. 50 students along with 5 teachers got into the bus Staff and children got to enjoy this fun filled party. There were plenty of games and cartoon characters at the party. The children played the games and most of our children also won prizes. The children were very happy and excited to see Santa Claus. Santa Claus gave snacks and gifts to them and they also got the chance to see the magic show which was very funny.



On 20th December 2016 the enthusiastic Jeevan Dhara boys participated in a football tournament organized by Saran NGO. They played matches with three organizations like Saran NGO, Aakansha and Leh foundation. Our boys played very well and they reached quarter final in the third match. The players were given free Jersey and snacks after the match.



On 24th December 2017 Jeevan Dhara conducted Addiction awareness program at Tata Institute of Social Science. Where the volunteers of Apnalaya center were shown a documentary film called Pratigya based on Addiction. Our staff Mrs. Sana gave a speech on addiction and explained the concept through a power point presentation. After the presentation Mrs. Jyoti Chavan sang a song about the evils of these vices and Mr. Sunil Chavan gave a talk on how to stay away from the evils of these drugs.



On 30th December 2016 Jeevandhara was invited for the Christmas tree party 10 boys and 10 girls attended the party. Games and snacks were served to them and gifts were distributed to each and every student. Prizes in cash and kind were given to the winner of the game. The students danced and enjoyed the Christmas party.



On 7th January 2017 we organized drawing competition from Jr.kg to 10th at cheeta camp study class. More than 230 students participated in the competition and the topics were 1) Flower pot 2) Rainy season 3) Village 4) Cleanliness. The students were very excited to participate and they made colorful drawing Prizes were distributed on the Annual day.



On 9th January 2017 there was a football match with Saraswati School Chembur. 11 Players from Jeevandhara played in this match. The game master was very happy about the performance of our players and we clicked photos with them. We beat the opposite team by 11:3 in this match so it was great success for us. The game master was agreed to give us a letter stating that they played game with Jeevandhara. The event ended and the players were very happy that they had won the match.



On 11th January 2017 we played a match with Tilak nagar FC. Our players of Jeevandhara played well and beat the opposite team by 8:5. It was a great win for us and everyone enjoyed the match.



On 21st Jan 2017 we conducted a football certificate distribution ceremony. The students who played well in the match with saran NGO got the certificate. And Kingsley sir who is the football coach of Jeevandhara was very enthusiastic. It was only because of him that it was possible for our students to obtain the certificate. The ceremony was held at Chunabhatti ground and around 30 students attended the ceremony. And three students from lallubhai compound performed dance and entertained the guest. The chief guest of the ceremony was Mr. Pradeep shah and luman ma'am gave away the certificate to the students.



On 29th Jan 2017 we conducted friendship day as a part of Balsansad. About 160 students of study class and all the staff participated in this program. We took the students to Trombay ground where there were more crowds of people. The students made friends with many strangers by tying on their hands a friendship band with the slogan "I will live free from addiction". The aim of this slogan was to spread awareness about addiction. The people came to know about our NGO and they were very happy when the small students tied friendship band on their hands.



On 29th Jan 2017 our football team participated in football tournament held at Borivali on Bosco boy's home ground. 8 players from our center played against leher foundation. Their names were Afnan, Deepak, Jamal, Papa, Tauqeer, Kasim, Gufran and Vinayak of which three players acted as substitute players. They reached till the quarter final but, Lehar foundation won the match.



On 11th Feb 2017 we organized a running race competition for the students of Jr. Kg to Fourth standard. A total of 208 Students participated in the event we started with a running race of two Standards combined from which we selected three winners from the event. On 13th Feb 17 we conducted a game of musical chairs for the students of standard fifth and sixth. A total of 38 students participated in the game and they really enjoyed themselves. We selected two winners from this event. For the students of standard 7th and 8th standard there was passing the ball game and a total of 84 students participated in this event in which two students were the winners.



On 18th February 2017 our Jeevandhara staff who attended the trainer's training of Mobile Creche gave the training to other staff of Jeevandhara. They did a drama and sang a song called "Haina maaze ke baat baccho" They also taught the silence lesson through one small activity.



On 26th February 2017 we celebrated the 11th Annual day at Cheeta Camp study classes. Shobha mam and Vinod sir lit the lamp and the staff said the prayers. The students showcased their talents by performing dance and drama. Vinod sir, Gene sir, Shobha mam and our senior staff of Jeevandhara gave away the prizes to the winners of the drawing competition and sports. We also gave the certificates to the students of the Dress making course. Selma mam distributed gifts to all our staff.



On 4th Mar 2017 our Jeevandhara staff Akseer, Sheetal and Sheeba who attended trainer's training of Mobile Creche did the same training for the other staff of Jeevandhara. They started the training by singing a small song on child. After that they taught the staff how to make puppets from waste materials. Like unused water bottle, old newspaper, old socks, and clothes. It was really a knowledgeable training for all our staff.



On 15th March 2017 the Jeevandhara staff participated in a women day rally organized by We action group. Many other NGO's and college students also participated in the rally which was held at Bandra east. The volunteers from we action group enacted street plays focusing on the issue of violence against women.



On 19th Mar 2017 we conducted our 1st Annual day and prize distribution ceremony of Lallubhai Compound study classes which is located at Mankhurd west. The Chief Guest of the day was Mr. Santosh Thorat and Jamila madam. Shobha mam and the parents lit the lamp and the students started with the prayers. Then the students performed a dance item and they also did a Marathi drama. Our chief guest Santosh Sir and Jamila Madam gave away the prizes to the winners of drawing competition. The students were very happy as they enjoyed themselves a lot and the event was a great success.



On 20th Mar 2017 we conducted balwadi a certificate distribution ceremony. A total of 50 balwadi students and their parents participated in the event. We called our study class teachers and tailoring class teacher to give away the certificate to the balwadi students. We have three balwadi classes and on the same day we while distributed the certificates to all these three balwadi classes. Some children said the rhymes while another child recited the number names. Their parents were so proud of their children that they were taught good morals by our Jeevandhara balwadi class teachers.



On 24th Mar 2017 we conducted our 1st Balwadi certificate distribution program at Lallubhai Compound Balwadi classes. A total of 40 students and their parents participated in this program. We have three balwadi classes there and on the same day we had distributed the certificates to all these three balwadi classes. Shobha ma'am and our staff of lallubhai compound gave away the certificates to the children. The children recited rhymes after this their parents shared about their future plans that they would like to start self help groups in their area. The parents were also enthusiastic about taking part in Jeevandhara activities.
